**What does a weekend with FOBBs entail?**

Most of the group arrives Friday evening or Saturday morning. A few elect to come earlier and fit in a Friday walk in the park.

There is a variety of accommodation at Binna Burra. For a nominal fee, shared accommodation is available to FOBBs in the Groom Cottage or bunkhouse. You will need to provide linen/sleeping bag and book with FOBBs prior to the weekend if you intend staying in the Groom Cottage or bunkhouse.

On-site tents, caravan sites, tent sites and Binna Burra Lodge are alternative options. Bookings for these are essential on (07) 5533 3758.

If you are booked into the Lodge, there is a reduced tariff for FOBBs members and you can choose to provide your own food or purchase food from the Teahouse.

On Sunday there is the opportunity to have breakfast, provided free of charge by the Lodge.

On Saturday, FOBBs gather about 8 am at Groom Cottage, where the:

- Activities for the day are posted.
- Everyone chooses their own jobs, works at their own pace
- working as a group brings its own fun, there is always plenty of laughter involved.

On Saturday evening the FOBBs regroup for a reasonably priced meal. Each person/couple usually brings an item(s) to be raffled. The raffles raise money towards new equipment belonging to/used by FOBBs.

Newsletters are sent out at regular intervals to financial members and supporters, at least quarterly by email or by snail mail.
